<u>Blessed Carlo Acutis</u> (3 May 1991 – 12 October 2006) was an Italian Catholic website designer best known for documenting Eucharistic Miracles and Marian Apparitions. He catalogued them on a website he created before his death from leukaemia age 15. He was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist which became a core theme of his life. He was beautified by Pope Francis on 10 October 2020, two days before the 14th anniversary of his death.
