REFLECTION

The human species is the first link in the Great Chain of Being that is able to know that it does know. We can stand back and reflect upon our experiences, which is what we might mean by awareness. We can be fully loving, and we can also stand back and see ourselves hate, fear, lie, and hurt others. In that sense, an awful lot of people are rather un-conscious because they do not see such things. The animals give God glory just through their simple existence. Ducks do the duck thing, squirrels do the squirrel thing without any resistance to themselves or envy of the other. Eckhart Tolle, in his book *Guardians of Being*, says, "We have forgotten what rocks, plants, and animals still know. We have forgotten how to be--to be still, to be ourselves, to be where life is: Here and Now. . . . What is it that so many people find enchanting in animals? Their essence--their Being--is not covered up by the mind, as it is in most humans. *And whenever you feel that essence in another, you also feel it in yourself.*" I think that is very true.
