The fear experienced by the women and the disciples at the end of Markøs gospel shows us that even when we have profound spiritual experiences, fear can often force us into silence. The account of the Ascension in Mark urges us not to be afraid but to GO out. The Gospel of Mark is a gospel for hard times and for those who are struggling. This ending aims to empower us and give us courage even when the world around us tells us otherwise. It urges us to GO and tell. The disciples went out bringing \div good newsø everywhere. We too are called to be Easter People because we live with an assurance that pain, death and grief will not have the last word.
