**THE DEACON: CALLED TO SERVE:** On Sunday 17 June at 3pm in St Michael's Church, Enniskillen, Martin Donnelly of Enniskillen will be ordained as the first permanent deacon in our diocese since the diaconate was re-introduced by Vatican II as a 'distinct ministry of service'. All are welcome to witness Martin's ordination.

**WHAT IS A DEACON?** On this Pentecost Sunday we begin a series of reflections on the Diaconate. The ministry of Deacon goes back to the earliest days of the Church (see Acts of the Apostles 6: 1-6). A deacon is an ordained minister of the Church, one who serves in the parish and in the wider community. The Second Vatican Council brought forward a renewal of ministry for both lay and ordained - by our baptism we are all called to participate in the saving work of the Church. Among the wide range of ministries in the Church today is that of the permanent Deacon, a ministry that includes married men.
