**Confirmation 2018**

On this Sunday, 22<sup>nd</sup> April, we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in St Michael's Church at 3.00pm.

We ask children, parents and sponsors to take their places in the Church no later than 2.45pm.

**Please use your Booklet** which you will receive at the Church door during the ceremony and bring it home with you afterwards as a souvenir.

Sponsors have an important role in supporting the children in the practice of their faith. At the moment of anointing with Chrism the sponsor places the right hand on the shoulder and the left hand on the head of the candidate as a sign of support and encouragement.

In accordance with diocesan policy there are to be **no photographs during the Ceremony.**

Group photographs will be taken afterwards in the Crypt.
