Individual Confessions are not now possible. People are reminded of the longstanding pastoral practice, when penitent's access to the Sacrament of Reconciliation is restricted, that they can be assured that their sins are forgiven if they make an act of contrition with a firm resolve to approach the Sacrament of Reconciliation after the stay at home orders are lifted. Pope Francis has spoken on this in recent days and it is in line with the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

- Stay 2 metres (7ft) away from other people - Wash your hands as soon as you get home.
- You can spread the virus even if you don't have symptoms.

"Light a Candle by Text": Our candle shrine is now placed at the altar steps and is visible over the parish webcam. To request a candle, phone or text 07753-801237, giving the name and number of the person who wants the candle lit. We suggest initially that parishioners observe a limit of five candles in any one request. While the usual donation is 50p each, this can be given at a later time when it is convenient, either by digital payment, post or through the parish office letterbox.

REVISED ARRANGEMENTS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

During this time, the following parish arrangements apply:

- 1. Anniversary Masses:** If you wish to book an Anniversary Mass please contact 07917107238.
 - 2. Funerals:** Until further notice, the following Civil Regulations apply: (1) Undertakers are to bring the body of a deceased parishioner directly to the place of burial, without going to the Church. (2) There is to be no public wake. (3) At the Graveyard, the maximum permitted number of attendees is 10 persons. (4) The usual graveside prayer will be led by a priest or deacon (or, if necessary, a lay person). Regarding parish arrangements: parishioners who die will be remembered at our Morning Masses.
 - 3. Mass Arrangements:** Please see list and website address opposite.
 - 4. Lisbellaw Mass:** The 9.30am Sunday morning Mass at St Mary's Church remains suspended. The intentions for this Mass will be included in the 10.30am Sunday Mass in St Michael's Church.
 - 5. Convent Mass:** This 6pm Monday evening Mass and its intention is transferred to St Michael's Church. No congregation permitted.
 - 6. Eucharistic Adoration:** This will continue but only by webcam at this time.
 - 7. The Parish Office:** The Office is now closed. Emails, telephone messages and delivered letters will be checked once a day. Please leave a message on the answering service at (028) 6632-2075 then press 4 for Father Raymond; 6 for Monsignor Peter.
 - 8. Donating to the Parish: (1) Standing Order** - In this time especially, Parishioners are asked to kindly consider setting up a Standing Order with their bank Also available on our Parish Facebook page by means of the Standing Order, downloadable from our parish website.
