This Sunday, **28th April**, we welcome Bishop Liam MacDaid to give the Sacrament of Confirmation in St Michael's Church at 3.00pm.

- 1 *We ask children, parents and sponsors to take their places in the Church not later than 2.45pm and to observe a sacred silence in the Church.*
- 2 *Please us your Booklet which you will receive at the Church door during the ceremony and bring it home with you afterwards as a souvenir.*
- 3 *Sponsors have an important role in supporting the children in the practice of their faith. At the moment of Confirmation the sponsor places the right hand on the shoulder and the left hand on the head of the candidate as a sign of support and encouragement.*
- 4 *The Bishop has requested that there be no photographs during the Ceremony. He will be readily available for photographs afterwards.*
