- 1 The 6.00pm Vigil Mass on Saturday is reserved for Month's Mind Masses. The 9.30am Mass on Sunday mornings will also be used to commemorate Month's Mind Masses if and when necessary, or requested.
- 2 The 7.30pm Mass on Friday will be reserved, along with one other intention if necessary, for First Anniversary Masses.
- 3 Up to two anniversary intentions may be booked for the 10.00am Mass on Saturday. In the event of a funeral, the Intentions booked will still be remembered.
- 4 Out of consideration for all who may wish to book family anniversaries, parishioners are requested to book only one Mass for all deceased members of their family.
- 10.00 am Morning Mass Intentions: Normally, at the 10.00am 5 Mass we specially remember those whose names appear in the Parish Messenger. The 10.00am weekday Mass is the main daily community celebration. That being the case, it is considered most suitable and pastorally more prudent that funerals normally take place at this time, hence, funerals will be celebrated at the 10.00am Mass. Since any death is a loss to the whole parish it is important that the 10.00am weekday celebration should be the normal setting to ensure funerals be celebrated in the presence of the greatest possible representation from the parish community. In all instances, when there is a funeral during the 10.00am Mass, we will remember and mention those whose names appear in the Parish Messenger for the 10.00am Mass and include the name of the deceased whose funeral it Notices is. for
