# SUMMARY OF PRESENT REGULATIONS RE: FUNERALS DURING ONGOING COVID-19 PANDEMIC (cf. Northern Ireland Executive Regulations Guidance as from Monday 12 April 2021)

Observe social distancing (stand 6' apart) - Face Covering mandatory inside the church building - No gathering on street outside Anyone who is feeling even slightly unwell should remain at home for fear of infecting others.

- Families will confer with the undertaker to provide a list of attendees in compliance with the number now permitted by regulation for Masses. No pre - and post-funeral gatherings at this time.
- Face Masks must be worn inside the church.
- No physical interaction between sanctuary/altar area and the body of the church (no readers, no other forms of participation).
- Music by soloists only.
