Each week we will reflect on one of the five ways in which the Immaculate Heart of Mary has been offended or blasphemed against. This devotion has its origins in Fatima, given through a locution to Venerable Lucia at the request of Jesus. Our overarching theme will be, "to prevent war and bring peace into the world," and our intention throughout will be, "reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary".
