Korean Fathers Mission Awareness Visit to St. Michael's Church This Weekend 15th & 16th November- Mission Appeal St Patrick's Missionary Society - known as the Kiltegan Fathers - was founded on St Patrick's Day 1932 by Fr Patrick Whitney of the Diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnoise. From its beginnings in Nigeria, the Society's work has spread to Kenya, Brazil, Grenada, Malawi, Zambia, South Sudan, Cameroon, Zimbabwe, and South Africa. Many priests and lay volunteers from Irish dioceses, including Clogher, have served in these missions. Today the Society numbers 210 priests, 63 of whom are African, and 75 seminarians are preparing for priesthood. Eight new African members are expected to be ordained in 2025 - a living sign of how the seed sown by the Irish Church has borne fruit across the world. Through their visit to Enniskillen Parish, the Kiltegan Fathers remind us that mission is central to our identity as followers of Christ and that the Church itself is missionary by nature. They express gratitude for our past support and invite renewed commitment through the Mission Appeal, coordinated by Fr Tomás O'Connor, this weekend.
