## Prayer to St Dymphna Patron Saint of Anxiety and Mental Illness



"Light a Candle by Text": Our candle shrine is now placed at the altar steps and is visible over the parish web request a candle, phone or text 07753-801237, giving the name and number of the person who wants the candle lit. We suggest initially that parishioners observe a limit of five candles in any one request. While the usual donation is 50p each, this can be given at a later time when it is convenient, either by digital payment, post or through the parish office letterbox.

May & The Rosary: Our Holy Father Pope Francis wrote a letter to the whole Church urging us all, families especially, to pray the Rosary during the month of May. In view of the current pandemic, Pope Francis has added two prayers which can be recited after the Rosary, seeking the intercession of Our Blessed Mother to bring the Covid-19 pandemic to an end. #### REVISED ARRANGEMENTS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Anniversary Masses: If you wish to book an Anniversary Mass please contact 07917107238.

The Parish Office: The Office is now closed. Emails, telephone messages and delivered letters will be checked once a day. Please leave a message on the answering service at (028) 6632-2075 then press 4 for Father Raymond; 6 for Monsignor Peter.

Sacraments (First Confession, Holy Communion, Confirmation, Weddings and Baptisms): All arrangements are presently suspended until further notice.

FUNERALS (a) Wakes: Present Government Guidance and Regulations at this time prohibit public gatherings. Consequently, there are to be no public wakes and no full funeral Mass where people may gather.

(b) Funeral Mass: At this point, the risk of catching this virulent virus remains as high as ever. Parishioners who die are always remembered at the 10am Morning Mass on the day of the burial and families are encouraged to link in over the parish webcam on that morning. It seems very likely that there will soon be an option of a very small Funeral Mass in the Church itself under the following conditions: (a) only 10 people present; (b) no physical interaction between sanctuary/altar area and the body of the church (no readers, no music, no other forms participation). (c) anyone who is feeling even slightly unwell should not attend the funeral as they could be in the early stage of infection and therefore be very infectious themselves.

(c) The Rite of Christian Burial is held at the graveside, where the maximum permitted number of attendees is 10 persons.
