Christians are reminded of Jesus' prayer for his disciples that "they may be one so that the world may believe" (see John 17.21) Each year the Enniskillen Christian Unity Week Service is organised by Fermanagh Churches Forum in consultation with the host Church and rotates around the 4 larger Churches in the town. This year the Service will take place at 7.30pm on Thursday January 22nd in Enniskillen Presbyterian Church.
