- (a) Families will confer with the undertaker to provide a list of attendees in compliance with the number now permitted by regulation for Masses. No pre and post-funeral gatherings at this time.
- (b) Face Masks must be worn when entering, leaving and moving about the church.
- (c) No physical interaction between sanctuary/altar area and the body of the church (no readers, no other forms of participation).
- (d) Music by soloists only.
