

SUMMARY OF PRESENT REGULATIONS RE: FUNERALS DURING ONGOING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Divine Mercy (Sunday only)

Anyone who is feeling even slightly unwell should remain at home for fear of infecting others. Observe social distancing (stand 6' apart) - Face Covering mandatory while moving inside the church building - Avoid gathering on street outside.

- Families will confer with the undertaker to provide a list of attendees in compliance with the number now permitted by regulation for Masses. No pre - and post-funeral gatherings at this time.
- Face Masks must be worn when entering, leaving and moving about the church.
- One reader for the Scripture Readings; one reader for the Prayer of the Faithful. Otherwise no physical interaction between sanctuary altar area and the body of the church.
- Music by soloists only.

- 3. Next Confirmation Preparation Mass: Sunday, 6th March, 10.30am. The invitation is to turn up in person and bring the family.
- 4. Service of Light: Tuesday 22nd March at 6.30pm over the parish webcam.
