Do This In Memory Mass: for all children in St Michael's Parish preparing for First Confession & First Holy Communion in 2022 this Sunday 23rd January at 9.30am Mass in St Mary's, Lisbellaw & 10.30am Mass in St Michael's Church. Catholic Schools Week - Today marks the beginning of Catholic Schools Week 2022. During this week, we aim to celebrate the unique contribution that Catholic schools, both primary and post-primary, make to supporting each other and living out Jesus' message of the Gospel. This year's theme is 'Catholic Schools: Living Life to the Full'. Our parish is joining in the celebrations. Sunday of the Word of God - Sunday 23rd January is also a day set aside for the celebration, study and dissemination of sacred Scripture; Scripture is a foundational part of our Catholic tradition and central to our relationship with God. Let us open our minds to understand the mission of Christ and the Church in our world through the Word of God. Week of Praver for Christian Unity continues until Tuesday next. The theme this year is "We saw the star in the East, and we come to worship him" (Mt 2:2). It is a call to unity, from north, south, east and west, old and young, women and men. The resources for this year were compiled in Lebanon and reflect the civil conflict and experiences of the people there; a yearning for a light leading to the Saviour who overcomes darkness. Diaconate Ordination of Paul Flynn: On Wednesday, 2nd February (The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord), Bishop Larry Duffy will ordain Paul Flynn as a Deacon for service in the Diocese of Clogher.
