Trócaire Lenten Campaign 2022: Families in Zimbabwe have been struggling with the triple challenges of Covil-19, climate change and a devasted economy which are exacerbating the daily struggles they face. According to the World Food Programme, 63% of the Zimbabwean population of over 15 million live under the poverty-line. Before the coronavirus outbreak, 7.7. million Zimbabweans faced food shortages after a drought and cyclone in 2019, and ongoing drought in the last year has exacerbated the situation. This has been compounded by rampant inflation.
