

SUMMARY OF PRESENT REGULATIONS RE: FUNERALS DURING ONGOING COVID-19 PANDEMIC Anyone who is feeling even slightly unwell should remain at home for fear of infecting others.

Observe social distancing (stand 6' apart) - Face Covering mandatory while moving inside the church building - Avoid gathering on street outside.

- Families will confer with the undertaker to provide a list of attendees in compliance with the number now permitted by regulation for Masses. No pre - and post-funeral gatherings at this time.
- Face Masks must be worn when entering, leaving and moving about the church.
- One reader for the Scripture Readings; one reader for the Prayer of the Faithful. Otherwise no physical interaction between sanctuary altar area and the body of the church.
- Music by soloists only.

The next thing now for the Confirmation Candidates is to get REGISTERED. The details on how to do that have been sent to the schools. Please also supply the details of your child's baptism for the Parish Register here. If your daughter or son has been baptised

here in St Michael's Parish, we have those details already. If not, you need to get those details off your child's Certificate of Baptism. (Ask that parish for a Certificate of Baptism). If your child has not been baptised, please let us know soon. All those who are receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation this year are warmly invited with their families to some special preparation Masses here at St Michael's Parish. In a similar way to the Do this in Memory programme, we want to encourage our children to learn more about their faith through witnessing Mass and the faith of those around them. This is a new initiative, alongside

the preparation children will do in school, that hopes to draw us all, candidates and Parishioners, into the great gift of the Sacraments!
